Dear Parents,

It is hard to believe that schools have been closed now for four weeks. This has been a very challenging time for parents, pupils and staff and I would like to commend you all for the tremendous job you are doing.

To all our parents, I know that home learning has not been easy and has been physically and mentally exhausting but by getting to children to watch the learning videos and engage in the online learning tasks set by the teachers, you are preparing the children for a smooth return to school.

You will have seen on the media that the school closure has been extended to the 5th of March. The Executive are due to meet on the 18th February to decide if schools will reopen on the 8th March or if there will be an extension to the school closures. As soon as we receive any information we will keep you informed.
