- As a school we strive to give pupils the skills needed to prepare them for an exciting digital future.
- We hold five special awards for ICT.
- We were awarded the 360 Degree Safe Online Safety Mark from SWGFL and were the first school in NI to be awarded the CR-IS Badge (Cyber Resilience and Internet Safety Badge) from Digital Schools.
- We hold the Digital Schools Award NI, the Naace Mark and the Naace Third Millennium Learning Award.
- Teaching about eSafety is a priority and our children love interacting with our mascot eSafetysaurus and learning about our monthly esafety codes.
- Every class has access to an interactive whiteboard, a computer, a printer, laptop and iPad.
- Our UICT Coordinator teaches full time in our modern ICT Suite with access to 32 PCs and laptops. Every year group has a set of iPads to use in the classroom.
- Our children have access to online reading programs through the use of Bug Club, MyON and Accelerated Reading.
- We are proud of the many exciting software programs, hardware tools and online learning opportunities that we provide for our children.
